## The Tainan Hospital

### ----- Its Story and Needs

OUR Church has from the earliest beginnings of her work in Formosa recognized the true ideal of a mission, in uniting the medical and evangelistic branches, the association of bodily with spiritual healing as exemplified by our Divine Master. We cannot conceive of our Lord saying, "Thy sins be forgiven Thee." Without His also saying, "Take up the bed and walk," and we believe that, after nearly 2,000 years, our Lord's method of work still remains the best.

This booklet is to tell something of the first hospital ever founded in the island of Formosa. Of its work, and of its present urgent needs.

### EARLY DAYS.

In 1865, James L. Maxwell, M.A., M.D., the first Formosan missionary of our Church, crossed from Amoy to begin medical mission work in the capital city of Tai-wanfoo---now known as Tainan. A house was
